Number of steps	<u>First day:</u> (06 steps) 1- A stop in the major railway facilities (the Souk Ahras Tunnel and 07 Bridges) 2- Visit Targa and the natural sources of water. 3- Visiting the natural greenery area and its monuments 4- A visit to the iron mine in the Oak Division 5- A visit to Mifras (Oued Migras) with a break and lunch with a local family. 6- The Hemisi visit (the train tunnel between Hemisi and the historical cave of blood with the Tunisian border).

	<p><u>Second day</u> : (05 steps)</p> <p>1- A stop at the major railway facilities (the Souk Ahras Tunnel and Jisour al-Zarourieh)</p> <p>2- A visit to the Wadi Al-Shouk station with a presentation on the Great Battle of Wadi Al-Shouk</p> <p>3- Take a walking tour for a distance of 02 km to the waterfalls of Al-Hobaja</p> <p>4- A break with a local family lunch (within the framework of encouraging local tourism)</p> <p>5- Visit Al-Dariah (visiting the Roman ruins of the city of Al-Mador)</p>
<p>Transport from the countyseat of the wilaya</p>	<p>-Train: Souk Ahras - Sidi Badr: distance 36 km, price 50 dinars, duration 50 minutes</p> <p>-Train: Souk Ahras - Derayah: distance 36 km, price 50 dinars, duration 50 minutes</p> <p><u>Note</u>: We suggest that the visit to this route be with a tourist agency to ensure the presence of a tourist guide because of the cultural and historical nature of this tourist route.</p>
